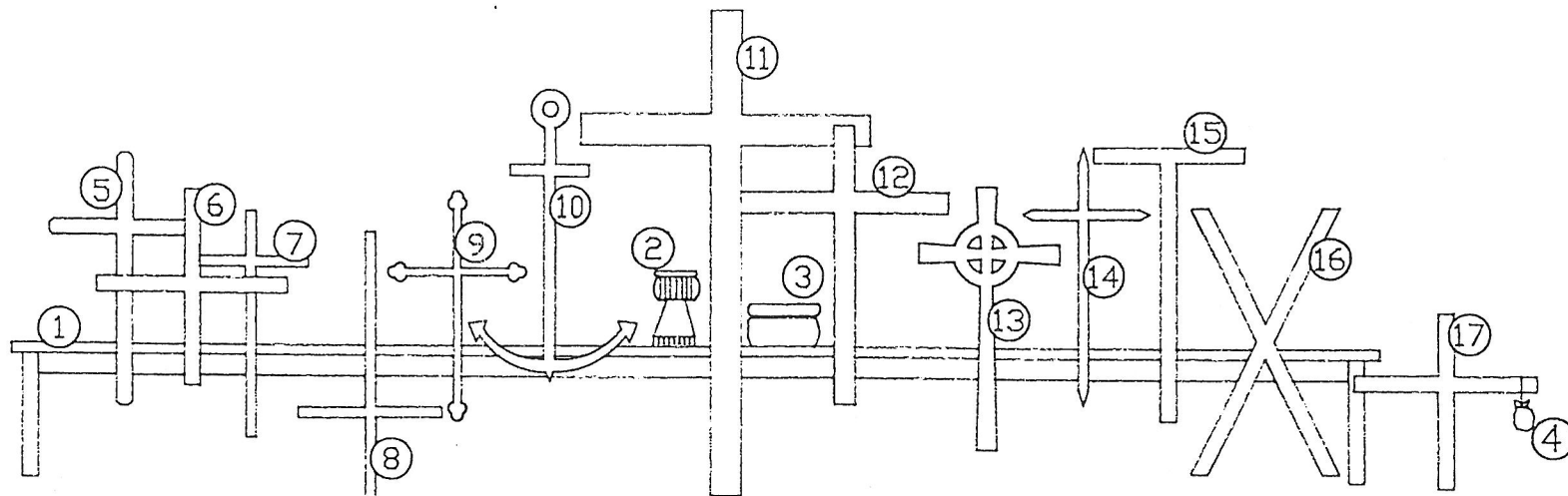


Legend of the Lord's Supper Mural and Crosses



① Holy Communion Table

Where the elements of wine and bread are consecrated to symbolize the body and blood of Christ. Where Christ celebrated the Passover Feast with his disciples.

② Holy Communion Chalice

Also called the cup of salvation which holds the wine to be consecrated

③ Loaf of Bread

Symbolizing Christ as the bread of life. This bread never goes stale.

④ Judas' Pouch

Believed to hold 30 pieces of silver for his betrayal of Christ.

⑤ Latin Cross

An upright cross with the lower portion of the vertical twice as long as the upper part above the crossarm. Believed to be the type of cross Christ was crucified upon.

⑥ Greek Cross

A cross formed by four equal arms. This cross was developed by artistic Greek culture - thus explaining its name.

⑦ Latin Cross

Same as above.

⑧ St. Peter's Cross

St. Peter believed he was not worthy to be crucified in the same manner as his Lord - so he requested to be crucified up-side down.

⑨ Budded Cross

A Latin or Greek cross with trefoil ends representing the Holy Trinity.

⑩ Anchor Cross

The top part of the anchor is shaped like a cross - showing Christ to be our anchor and our hope. Many of the disciples were fishermen and traveled by boat.

⑪ The Main Christ Cross

Also a Latin cross. This cross is so vivid that you can almost believe it to be the actual cross carried by Christ.

⑫ Latin Cross

Same as above.

⑬ Celtic Cross

A Latin cross with a circle. The circle emphasizes the eternal effect of the redemption secured by the death of Christ.

⑭ Passion Cross

Symbol of Christ suffering for his mission to bring salvation to the human race.

⑮ Tau Cross

It is shaped like the Greek letter of that name. It is often called the Old Testament Cross because, according to tradition, Moses lifted up the brazen serpent with this cross. It was also used by the Egyptian Christians.

⑯ St. Andrew's Cross

A cross leaning like an X. It is the national cross of Scotland. Andrew also did not believe he was worthy to be crucified like Christ.

⑰ Greek Cross

Same as above.
